

Reviewer's Comments:

I thought that some of my questions were not answered by authors.

Q1: How many people were working in this area?

Q2: What percentage of their reached workers in this study?

Author's Feedback:

A1: According to the survey conducted throughout the study area, 5822 goldsmiths were working.

A2: In terms of the census survey, 100% population was reached. The reconnaissance survey was also conducted at the time of the census survey. For the FGD and Interview only 0.86% of the total goldsmiths were reached, but we would like to say this strongly that this number of respondents were representative of the entire population. This is because the reconnaissance survey found that the health risks are similar in particular type of units, e.g. the health risks for the goldsmiths of soldering units are similar. The respondents selected during this survey represented the health risks of a total population of a particular type of unit of an integrant cluster. So, we would like to ensure that the sample size of the respondents was representative of the total population; and gathering of more respondents were not necessary to represent the situation. However, the methodology has been rephrased (see line 89 to 102), and definitions of unit, market and cluster have also been given (line 532 to 539) for a better clarification.
