The article presents interesting (even important) philosophical ideas based on a post-			
positivistic worldview, justified by the realities of quantum physics, with implications for			
research and education. The document now expresses the views of the author sufficiently well			
for the interested reader. The abstract is now clear enough to accommodate the author's			
preferred title. Whilst a simpler title would have been my preference on the grounds of clarity,			
the author's choice in not oversimplifying is respected and the reason for that understood and			
accepted, as are some remaining minor difficulties in language, so-called L1 interference. I			
would personally have preferred more emphasis on expanding the didactic and			
methodological implications rather than on the historical and descriptive account of quantum			
mechanics. But that is subjective: it is after all the author's opinions being expressed here. For			
future works I can not over-emphasize the difficulties of writing works requiring			
philosophical subtlety in a second language and the importance of getting it right at the			
earliest possible stage. I salute the author in their efforts and know from personal experience			
just how difficult this can be.			
I recommend the article (barring any type-setting issues) for publication in its present form. In			
my opinion it now satisfies the requirements of an opinion article for Advances In Research			
without need of revision.
