<p>I still do not find the regime analysis relevant for the aims of the paper. I do not find any clear connection between the knowledge generated by this analysis (i.e. which political party allocated more funds to Districts) and the overall conclusions of your work. This does not mean that the data you collected are useless; I just suggest you to focus more on the historical trend of the funds allocation (the three political eras) rather than on which party was leading at that time. Moreover, in my opinion, such an analysis may be useful only if compared with other countries that can be considered homogeneous in respect to Ghana.</p> <p>I still suggest an extensive English proofreading.</p>	<p>Thank you very much for the comments.
