<p>The paper is revised and is good, however needs clarification on important result</p> <p>Your results say “Over two-thirds (71% SE 30) of the children with same-sex married parents who had ever had sexual intercourse reported that they had been forced to have sex against their will at some point. ...., there is a striking gender disparity for this group that is not present in any other family type: every female adolescent, but no male adolescents,</p> <p>The question asked from males and females were different female adolescents were asked, “Were you ever physically forced to have sexual intercourse against your will?” Males were asked, “Did you ever force someone to have sexual intercourse <u>against her will?</u>” according to your results it was 0 % males have answered positively as it is different from what was asked from females this may be the reason for gender disparity line 506-512</p>
