Compulsory REVISION comments	The manuscript reports on the analysis of formulation composition on the release of fluconazole from O/W creams and PEG ointments, with some in vitro tests of the antimicrobial performance. The information may have some practical interest. However, the English in quite bad and should be revised in detail. For example, in the abstract, there is a random use of past, present and future tenses. "In this study I prepared" Since there are three authors, this sentence is odd. "Results obtained showed that the PEG ointment formulations showed better fluconazole release over the O/W cream formulations" Please define "better" (faster, slower, complete?). Also, "better" should not be used in the conclusions. Language is a major issue along the manuscript. The introduction should avoid description of general concepts and focus more on the already developed fluconazole creams and ointments. The aims of the work are not clear. Table 1. What are the units of the components? Grams, milligrams, millilitres? Figure 1. Please indicate the units of viscosity Table 2. Please provide the units of D. Moreover, this parameter should be given with more significant digits.
