

Based on reviewer comments two important points have not answered by Authors.

1. Acute toxicity – the answer is not scientific. According to my opinion toxicity part is very important when using non standardized extracts.

As I was unable to perform the LD₅₀ due to shortage of extract I would like to skip this portion.

2. Ethical Issue – There is no information about ethical permission for using animals.

I have already mentioned the ethical issue in my revised paper which is highlighted in yellow colour and mentioned in line 396-401.

Additional Issue-

1. Authors need to do identification and authentication of plant from an approved botanist.

I have done the identification and authentication of the plant from Bangladesh National Herbarium Please find the paper attached.

2. The plant name is not followed throughout manuscript scientifically as *Hiptage benghalensis* or *H.benghalensis*.

I have checked the paper and made correction accordingly.
