Line 95 – 2nd ‘at’ is not needed 8. Line 111-112 – Description in sentence would be better to understand whether the materials were purchased/a kind gift. It may be Ltd. to denote Limited. 9. Line 184 – drug/normal saline 10. There are some values missing zero (0) before the decimal like in ‘line 199’. 11. Fig 1 and Fig 2 might be titled as ‘% inhibition of analgesia of MEMS’ and ‘% inhibition of inflammation of MEMS’, respectively. 12. In Line 282 – Paracetamol dose might be 100mg/kg. 13. In Table 04 there is alignment problem especially in
