Compulsory REVISION comments	The paper studies the glucose and cholesterol-lowering effect of <i>Coccinia grandis</i> 's leaf extract in normal and diabetic rats. While these parameters are interesting to study, they are not exactly new with regards to this plant. The authors themselves have pointed this out multiple times in their manuscript. Their claim that it has never been studied before using extract of ethanol medium is not acceptable as one of the papers they cited actually used ethanol extract in their study. The authors should give specific reasons why this current research is significant from the other studies and why is it important to have it published since it is reporting already known knowledge. Taking into account the possibility that this manuscript does get published, I think it is appropriate to include the following comment: The manuscript contains occasional amounts of grammatical and typographical problems (which I do not list here). The authors could resolve these problems by thoroughly reading the manuscript and seeking advice from a native English speaker or a language editor. Problems of this sort (while minor) should definitely not appear in print.
