Manuscript BMRJ3513, Parasitological evaluation of domestic water sources in a rural community in Nigeria

Taking into account the importance of the subject studied, I recommend publication after additional editing, following the comment made by reviewer SG_RJ. In particular the recommendation to indicate the genus name of *Strongyloides* spp. rather than attempt to provide the species name, which according to the reviewer cannot be accurately distinguished. Regarding the hookworms found, the authors should indicate that these may not necessarily be human hookworms.

To my understanding, even if some of the parasites found are animal and not human pathogens, the findings indicate that the water are contaminated.

In terms of the form of publication, in my opinion the manuscript should be published as a short communication or a note and does not justify a full paper.
