They found that higher expression of Claudin-4 can be used as a molecular marker in follow up of low- grade and non-invasive lesions, as well as decreased expression of Claudin-1 and -3 in non-invasive lesions and invasive urothelial carcinomas is no conclusive. In my opinion, the correlation between Claudin-4 expression can be of clinical interest considering the therapeutic with clostridium perfringes enterotoxin. In the Introduction there are more recent data about the incidence of cancer. See 2012 statistics on Globocan. This should be included in the References References should reviewed.
