FINAL EVALUATOR'S comments on revised paper (if any)	Authors' response to final evaluator's comments
<p>Most of the technical comments/questions were answered, although some of them in a rather vague manner (e.g., instead of "we don't think so", I would expect a solid argument, in the case of disagreement with the reviewer's opinion). Some were ignored, but these are not critical.</p> <p>A number of the grammatical and style/formatting problems were corrected, but many still remain. It seems like I have put more effort in reviewing the manuscript and picking out the errors than the authors in correcting them.</p> <p>Few examples of sloppy formatting:</p> <p>140 Red Mud</p> <p>143 Red mud</p> <p>163 red mud (correct)</p> <p>124 Figure.1</p> <p>136 Figure 3 (correct)</p> <p>137 Figure-3, Table.4</p> <p>Missing spaces and dots in the authors' names in References</p> <p>My primary recommendation would be to revise again, this time more carefully.</p> <p>However, in general, I believe the reviewer should not have an absolute power over the paper, so I'll leave it to the editor's decision, to what extent insist on proper paper shape. Having already provided several pages of remarks, I don't have the capacity to act as a free proofreader again. Should there be interest, I am willing to provide detailed markings for a modest fee.</p>
